In accordance with the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C. Sec. 631, et seq.,
Pursuant to the regulations of the Judicial Conference of the United States,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Mikel H. Williams and Larry M. Boyle be,
and hereby are, reappointed as United States Magistrate Judges, at the salary as fixed
by the Judicial Conference of the United States.

Said United States Magistrate Judges shall continue upon the performance of
their duties at 12:01 a.m. on the 30th day of March, 2000, and 1st day of April, 2000,
respectively, but prior to the commencement of such duties, they shall take the oath or
affirmation prescribed by 28 U.S.C. Sections 453 and 631(g).

Said United States Magistrate Judges are to hold and discharge the duties of their
respective offices for an additional term of eight (8) years from the date of this appointment,
subject to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. Sec. 631(I), unless sooner removed.

The said United States Magistrate Judges are specially designated to hear, try, and
determine misdemeanor offenses as defined by 18 U.S.C. Sec. 3401; to perform all duties

as defined by 28 U.S.C. Sec. 636 and the Local Rules and Orders of this court; and to perform such other additional duties that are not inconsistent with the Constitution and the laws of the United States.

This Order of Appointment shall be filed and entered of record in the court by the clerk, and the clerk shall forward a certified copy of the same to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts, as required by 28 U.S.C. Sec. 631(h).
