COURT REPORTER MANAGEMENT PLAN
FOR THE DISTRICT OF IDAHO

GENERAL ORDER NO. 24

Pursuant to a request of the Circuit Council of the Ninth Circuit, the District of Idaho, adopts the following as its Court Reporter Management Plan.

The District of Idaho is served by three full time Reporters and one Contract Reporter. The Reporters are authorized to perform their duties at any of the three places of holding Court within Idaho, i.e. Boise, Pocatello and Moscow and any other place within the District as may be designated by any United States District Judge or United States Magistrate.

The Reporters will function under a modified pool system with two of the Reporters providing primary services to each of the two active Judges. The third Reporter will provide primary services to the two Senior Judges.

Line authority over the District's Reporters is hereby delegated to the United States District Clerk who will monitor the workload, quality and charges of all Court Reporters. The Clerk on an equitable basis shall have the authority to reassign the Reporters as between Judges or to the United States Magistrates on an as-needed basis. The Contract Court Reporter will only be utilized when necessary.

The purpose of this plan will be to obtain optimum use of its Court Reporting services making sure the time of its Reporters is fully occupied and avoiding delay in Court proceedings and preparation of transcripts.
